Frequency 146.480. Simplex. No PL Tone.

On Saturday August 24, monitor 146.480 for further information.

Emergency frequencies on HF:

Primary: 60 meters channel 5, dial frequency 5403.5 USB

Seconday: 60 meters channel 4, dial frequency 5371.5 USB

Backup: 75 meters, 3990 plus or minus LSB

Use mobile radios - not handhelds.

Vehicle antennas acceptable. External antennas and power source preferable.

Winlink will be available at net control for email access.
