

Stagecoach 100 mile run 21-22 September 2019:

The Stagecoach Run is our most challenging event. This year the event organizers have added a 100 mile bicycle race on essentially the same course and requested tracking of bicycle riders at Cedar Ranch, Boundary, and Hull Cabin. Providing this tracking would probably require two shifts at Boundary and Hull Cabin and a longer day at Cedar Ranch.
